**COMPAR-EU** project aims to identify, compare, and rank the most effective and cost-effective self-management interventions for adults in Europe living with one of the four high-priority chronic conditions: type 2 diabetes, obesity, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, and heart failure.

The self-management interventions help patients to increase their skills and confidence in managing their chronic condition with the intention to promote, maintain, or restore their health.

Our main product is an innovative information technology platform featuring self-management tools, also known as decision-making tools for self-management, that provide support for policymakers, guideline developers, healthcare professionals as well as patients. The platform will help them to make informed decisions on the adoption of the most suitable self-management interventions.
